23 September 1992. Washington D.C. Activists from Greenpeace and the Rainforest Action Network (RAN) blockaded the entrance to the World Bank annual meeting with a 3 metre by 5 metre "dam" to call for an end to all support for the Sardor Sarovar Dam project in India. A recently released 358 page independent report on the Sardar Sarovar project listed 39 specific areas where the World Bank and Indian Government had violated Bank regulations and Indian Law. The dam project threatens to turn 150,000 Indian people off their land, submerge tens of thousands of acres of farms and forests, destroy fisheries and increase diseases.
