Dear Friends, We can help you send xerox copies of the articles, selections, books listed below. We have evolved a down-to-earth technique for cutting down xeroxing costs. First we reduce normal size printed pages of a book on a xeroxing machine. Eight of these reduced prints are then stuck on a B4 size sheet (10 inch x 14 in.) This becomes a master copy out of which further reprints are made. So, for 80 paise you get 8 pages of a normal book - though reduced in size. Normal hardbound books are priced at 50 paise per printed page. We give you a printed page for 10 paise.
