Dear Dr. Pal,

The Director, Central Rice Research Institute, Cuttack (Mr. Ramiah) is proceeding on leave for 40 days from the end of this month and on the expiry of the leave, is likely to take up a post under the Food & Agricultural Organization of the United Nations. Before allowing him to proceed on leave, it has to be decided who should take over charge of the post. In this connection, it is suggested that Dr. N. Parthasarathy, Officiating Head of Division of Botany at the Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi is, by virtue of his experience and qualifications, best fitted to officiate as Director. It may be necessary, in due course, to consult the Union Public Service Commission for making permanent arrangements.
