Re: Your Donation to our High School for a
Science Block-

I contacted Shri M. Subbaraya Iyer Advocate of
Madras regarding the exemption certificate about which we
talked of while you were here. He has put me on the line
and I am herewith enclosing a letter from Shri Subbaraya Iyer
to you.

I remember to have told you while on journey from
Watrap to Madurai by car, that Rs. 5000/- would suffice for a
science block. But you had agreed for any sum. The Engineer
in charge of our present building construction when approached
says at least a sum of Rs. 7000/- is necessary for a decent
block. I am sure you will be magnanimous to sanction that
amount.

As the Madras Advocate says, the donation has to be
paid in two instalments, one within 31st March '59-Rs. 3500/-
and another 3500/- after April.

Madras I have contacted the Commissioner of Income Tax,
New Delhi and the Income Tax officer, Virudhunagar to send
the exemption certificate well in advance, so as to enable
you send the donation in time. As soon as it is received,
I shall mail it to you.

I have written a separate letter to you some 2 days
back through your nephew Kannan and I request you to help me in
my younger brother's case.
