Dear Dr. Krishnan,

It is a long time since we met (1937 when you were took me round Calcutta) but I am sure you have not forgotten those friendly days we spent together, just as I have not.

I am sending you some of our latest publications (in another packet) as I would like you to read them and also let me have your views on them. I am also sending you some copies of our paper on which I work, I would like to have your comments on it too.

But most of all I want you to help us with regard to a new feature - Under The Lamp Of Learning - that we intend to start. In this feature we want to show our people what good work is being done in our Universities and centres of research and learning, work of value to our people and country, work done in the face of great difficulties. To-day the mass of our countrymen ^{feel} completely helpless and without hope for the future. We want to reawaken their pride in themselves and their fellow-countrymen, their confidence that they can come together to win freedom, build a new India. To this end, our new feature will help and we want you to help us in it.

I am writing to a friend of ours at Allahabad University, Prakash Chandra Gupta, to see you and interview you on the work you and your colleagues and pupils are doing, and to write for us a simple non-technical description of this work. I am sure you will assist him to make it a real good objective article, which will help to make our readers understand just what is being done by one of our foremost scientists.

If you are in Bombay any time, I do hope you will look me up, I am almost always in Bombay. Itx has always been my regret that we have not been able to meet since I returned to India in 1939. But I hope this will be remedied soon.
