

Dear Shri Mustafy,

REF: Your D.O.No.7(1)10/62-E.I., dated 13-9-1963.

I am thankful to you for the above communication advising me that consequent on the D.G.'s refusal to grant me earned leave for 32 days, I will be entitled to take that leave after 15th September, 1963.

I have since received a telegraphic request from the Secretary stating that I should continue to serve as Director till 1-10-1963. I have agreed to do so. This will mean that instead of taking the leave, I will be putting in an extra period of service.
