My Dear Sir,

Many thanks for speaking to Mr. Ramchandani of the All India Radio for granting the requisite permission to the local A.I.R. Officer for showing round the Scientists of the Soviet Anti-magnetic ship "Zarya". The Permission came in time and the scientists were happy. On the 30th evening they were taken round the University and the Vice-Chancellor met them over "a Tea".

Dr. Bologov, has asked me whether it will be possible for him to obtain the Critical Frequencies of the  $F_2$  layer over Bombay during the period 5th to 25th September, before the ship leaves Bombay Harbour on the 5th October. Shri Khanna, the Officer-in-charge, here, who has the data, has difficulty in supplying the data, without proper authority. According to him, Shri T. Rajamanickam, Research Engineer, Akashvani Bhavan, New Delhi 1, can authorise him to do so. But I am afraid, that Shri Rajamanickam himself would need somebody else's authority.

I shall be grateful, if you would very kindly do what is appropriate in this matter. If the data is passed on to me, I shall arrange to give it to Dr. Bologov, if this reaches me by the 4th September. If this reaches me after the 4th, I shall pass them on to the local Consulate, for onward transmission

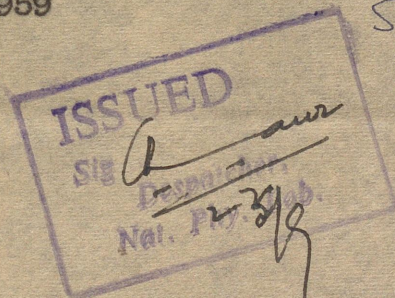

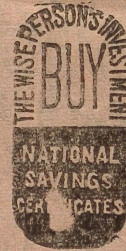
