





We have previously recommended Ch. Ranjit Singh of Chattarpur for Amber Sonora, Sona Lekha wheat seeds. He is one of the most progressive farmers in Delhi, who adopts all necessary practices. Last year he had 2 acres under S227 sown by dibbler and used ^{seed} at the rate of 6 kg per acre and produced 120 maunds. He gave 100 maunds to us. This year he had 2 acres of composite maize, and I am hoping that his yield will be any where of the order of 100 maunds if not more. Subject:- MULTIPLICATION - IMPROVED WHEAT SEEDS

Dear Sir,

Large acreage of wheat are sown every year at Government Military Farms under the control of this office to grow more food in the country at the present juncture. In 1965, your institution was good enough to supply us seeds of LERMA ROJO and SONORA and we have sufficient seed stock of these two varieties.

2 We have now been unable to obtain the seeds of new varieties like KALYAN-SONA, SHARBATI SONORA, SONALIKE and Tripple-dwarf wheats for our Military Farms. We are, therefore, again approaching you for allotment of seeds of the above varieties to the extent it is possible.

3 It is mentioned that our requirement is minimum for 100 acres. This office also undertakes the commitment to hand over the entire produce to your department after the harvest. In fact we are also prepared to carry out sowing and cultivation of these new varieties under your supervision and in collaboration with you at Military Farm MEERUT, which has about 500 acres of good fertile soil with adequate supply of tubewell irrigation water for wheat cultivation. The seeds thus multiplied can be handed over to your institute for further distribution to farmers.

4 I will be thankful for early communication from you regarding allotment of maximum wheat seeds. The proposal made in para 3 above may also be given favourable consideration and the details can be discussed in a meeting on further hearing from you.

5 Please acknowledge.

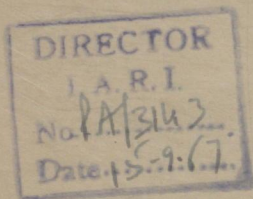


