Gentlemen,

The Secretariat of the 1961 IMEKO Conference wishes to inform you about an earlier resolution of our International Preparatory Committee, according to which scientific, educational and research institutions as well as industrial firms from countries participating in the Conference shall be invited to arrange a showing of their newest research achievements as well as their newest industrial products in the field of measurement and instrumentation.

The Secretariat — being charged exclusively with preparing the Conference proper — has entrusted the Hungarian Fair Bureau (organiser of Budapest Industrial Fairs and Exhibitions since 1906) — to arrange the INTERNATIONAL MEASUREMENTS AND INSTRUMENTS SHOW (IMIS, for short) during the duration of IMEKO 1961. This Show is to be arranged in two separate sections: „SCIENCE AND MEASUREMENT“ SECTION, open to scientific, research and educational institutions at reduced rates, for showing latest research achievements, and an „INDUSTRIAL INSTRUMENT-SHOW“ SECTION, open to instrument manufacturers, to show the very newest, top level products of their respective countries.

IMEKO 1961 is expected to exceed its quite successful predecessor of 1958 considerably in international participation. Even now, scientists from over 20 countries listed on the enclosed Membership list are participating in its preparation. In addition to 600-700 scientists from about 25 countries, participating in the Conference proper, this first full-fledged measurement and instruments show of Eastern and Western countries is expected to attract many more instrument users and makers from several European countries. Just as the first IMEKO Conference gathered instrument specialists from all sides for the first time to a common conference in 1958 — so is the INTERNATIONAL MEASUREMENTS AND INSTRUMENTS SHOW of 1961 in Budapest bound to achieve the same on just as broad a scale as the International

Conference it is aimed to support. We wrote „support“ intentionally, since the Budapest Fair Bureau, agreed to make all arrangements on a „non - profit“ basis. All net proceeds will be used to defray the expenses of synchronous translation, multilingual preprints and other Conference expenses necessary to assure an even greater international success for IMEKO 1961 - and to help the Conference „stand on its own feet“ financially.

We are aware of the fact that several significant large scale commercial exhibitions (INTERKAMA, MESUCORA, ACHEMA), are being organized in the present period and they all serve a very useful purpose of their own. Still, we feel certain, that the scientific purposes of the International Measurement Conference of 1961 are quite different in nature and that several important scientific institutions and industrial centers will want to see to it, that their country be equally well represented, not only on the lecture platform of this truly international Conference, but also in the Scientific and in the Commercial Sections of the exhibition, accompanying it.

The Secretariat of IMEKO 1961 shall continue to engage exclusively in preparing the International Measurements Conference, leaving further exhibition matters to the organizers of the Show. A general mailing is under preparation.

We felt, nevertheless, that we should inform you ahead of time, giving an opportunity to ask for advance information, by mailing the enclosed form directly to the BUDAPEST FAIR BUREAU, organisers of the International Measurements and Instruments Show. An invitation to IMEKO 1961 will be sent to you independently and we hope to welcome you at our Conference as well.

Dear Mr. Director:

It is most probably known to you, that the International Conference is to be held in Budapest from the 26th June to the 1st of July 1961.

This Conference - briefly known as IMEKO 1961 - is organized by an International Preparatory Committee of scientists from 22 countries, the name of which may be found in the enclosed membership-list. Just as its predecessor, IMEKO 1958, the Conference is to serve as an occasion for all scientist, researchers and other experts from many countries to gather for a scientific exchange of experiences as well as to establish a personal contact with their colleagues from abroad.

In agreement with the members of the International Preparatory Committee, the Secretariat is inviting Scientific Academies, as well as Government Institutions responsible for Standards, Weights and Measures in each of the countries represented in the International Preparatory Committee /list of which is enclosed/ in order these scientific bodies may represent themselves through official delegates at this scientific Conference, just as several have done at IMEKO 1958.

Your Organization, dealing primarily with the measurement and standardization of basic and complex physical quantities, would probably welcome the occasion for its research workers to discuss common scientific questions both in Lecture Halls and in Club Rooms of IMEKO 1961. More particularly, they might use the occasion to present a paper on some of their recent results./See the enclosed "First Information Bulletin"./

The I.P.C. of IMEKO 1961 would feel honoured to great leaders and staff members of your Institution at this truly international gathering of specialists in measurement, and looks forward to your reply with great interest.
