Mr. B.S. Madhava Rao had a brilliant career in the Madras and Mysore Universities before he came to Calcutta, obtaining a first class in the I.Sc. and then standing first in the first class in the B.Sc. examination of the Mysore University. He was then deputed to Calcutta with a scholarship in order to continue his studies for the M.Sc. degree, and in his two years work has fully sustained the reputation with which he came to this University. At the last M.Sc. examination in Pure Mathematics, he obtained a first class, standing second in the list, and his performance was in some ways even better than that of the man who stood first. Mr. Madhava Rao has also given proof of a distinct <sup>bent</sup> ~~bent~~ for mathematical research, and he is, in my opinion, likely to distinguish himself abroad if deputed to Europe. I strongly recommend the grant to him of a foreign scholarship.
