Dear Dr. Ranjekar:

This has reference to your letter dated February 3rd, 1969.

I am sorry that I could not attend to this earlier. I made enquiries at the Municipal Market and at the Victoria Zoological Gardens in Bombay about possibility of getting new-born black-faced monkey. As they have no regular programme to breeding them in captivity, it is rather difficult to get just new-born animals. But there are dealers in Municipal Crawford Market who get these animals for sale. I am advised to inform you that you should contact some of the dealers through the Superintendent (Dr. Periyar). When arranged, some one from your laboratory can come down to collect the specimen. Alternately you may also contact the Superintendent Victoria Gardens, directly. As the age of the young one is very important, I suggest that you contact these people and explain your requirements.

I thank you for the reprint you sent me. Please convey my greetings to Dr. Barnabas.
