I confirm having sent you the following cablegram today:-

I think Hindu Analytical literature conveys transference selfless heart

I beg to request you kindly to place the above before the
scientists taking part in your conference. According to my views the
Hindu Scientific literature suggests them very clearly and emphatically.

I beg to place the following before you by way of elucidation:-
Just as sound can be transferred from its speed of 1100 feet per sec.
to a speed of 1,86,000 miles per sec. by the movement of a diaphragm placed
in the magnetic field of a telephone or a loud speaker, similarly a single
selfless thought of man when worked by heart, with a concentrated, calm
and composed mind and brain, creates sound which shoots up in the sky
(Vacuum) with the speed of electricity, namely 1,86,000 miles per sec.
It permeates the sky and purifies it, which in its further course purifies
and rejuvenates air, light, water, earth and the universe which they
compose. Thus the Eternal Truth and Law continues..

There are various forms of ' air' circulating in the human
