Dear Siddhartha:

Thanks for your letter of October 12 regarding Fukuyama. (I would have answered sooner but we only got back from New York about one week ago.) As a matter of fact, my wife spoke to Fukuyama on the phone while we were in NY but he was very tight-lipped, though as is obvious from his Rand study, he dismisses India as a "Soviet ally" (as does his boss Haig, for that matter). Offhand the only thing I know about him is that before being inducted into the Haig State Department as Director for Near East (sic, it includes India) Affairs in the Policy Planning Division, he was with the Rand Corporation where he specialized in the Soviet Union, not South Asia. I will suggest to Sneider that he dig around some more.

I believe Dr. Parpart wrote you that he will be visiting India later this month along with Dr. Stephen Dean of Fusion Power Associates for a tour organized by C.S.I.R.

Originally I had been hoping Parpart would have an extra day in Bangalore during which he could have long discussions with you and your colleagues on the Riemann-LaRouche economic model. However, he is planning to stay in India for 8-10 days ^{and more} and visit Bombay during that time. He may be able to come back to Bangalore on Nov. 28th or Dec. 5th.
