

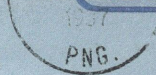

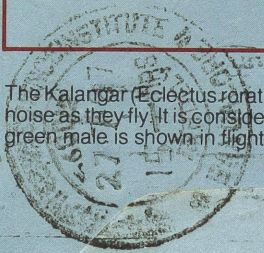

The Kalangar (*Eclectus roratus*) is found anywhere throughout the lowlands of Papua New Guinea. They grow about 40 cm long and make plenty of noise as they fly. It is considered that the female bird is more striking than the male. The mostly red female is seen on the left and the predominantly green male is shown in flight in the stamp area.
