Sub :- Distribution of royalties arising out of the
process on Baby food.

The Chief, Technology Utilization was kind enough to send me
a copy of the above communication.

After a prolonged Court Case, spread over nearly 5 1/2 years;
the Principal Civil Judge, Mysore issued a decree accepting the compro-
mise formula proposed jointly by all the litigants. The decree was
issued some time during October 1974. It took some more months to get
the certified copies and then for the CSIR to issue the necessary orders.

Some of the litigants have already retired from service. All
of us are getting elderly every day. It is fortunate that all are still
alive. If some of us are to pass away, it will create fresh problems
for the families and also for the CSIR and the CFTRI.

In consideration the above, I would feel thankful, if the
necessary action could be taken without much further delay. Your office
should have all the particulars on hand and it should not take much time
to make the necessary calculations and to make the payments. It is
already one month since the CSIR office addressed you on the subject.

Dear Dr. Amla,

I was rather surprised to note from your letter of March 29 that the CSIR has not, so far, transferred the royalty money, though the orders for the distribution were issued about two months ago. If there is any unexpected difficulty, they should at least advise the CFTRI about the reason for it.

The payments are all taxable in the same way as company dividends. That procedure has already been followed by the CFTRI. As far as I am aware there is no legal or other barrier to making the payment in the same way as in the past.


The CSIR should pay the entire amount with the interest that had accrued during the past six years.

I had also written to the CSIR requesting prompt action; but they have not so far sent me any reply. I feel therefore that your writing and even telegraphing to them followed by a personal visit and clearance of the formalities will be most helpful.

The D.G., Chief of Administration, the Law Officer and the other concerned had all taken active interest and had helped in reaching a settlement in respect of the Court Case. The delay could not be due to any lack of interest on their part. Even if there is any other cause, there would be no justification for withholding the paying at this stage.
