My dear Sir,

I am extremely sorry for not having written to you for a fairly long time. I was extremely busy with certain work relating to preparation of returns in a group of cases for the current assessment year and hardly had any time to devote even to some of the routine work. I am sure, you will understand that, being as I am in the month of March, I have absolutely no time even for my personal work. I also learnt from my father that you had written to him on a couple of occasions and wanted him to remind me about the work to be done for you. I wish, however, to assure you that I have always been conscious of the pendency of this work.

2. I, however, wish to inform you that I had an opportunity of discussing this matter with the Incometax Officer, Mysore, during one of my recent visits to Mysore. I understand that most of the other Scientists from C.F.T.R.I. have also approached him with the same problem but the solution which he seems to have given to them does not appear to me to be satisfactory.

3. I have decided to file a petition on your behalf to the Commissioner of Incometax, Bangalore, but it is premature to file this petition now, since the income in question relates

to the previous ~~xxx~~ year ended March 31, 1976, relevant to the assessment for 1976-77. The consideration of such a petition would be considered by the Incometax authorities only after April, 1976, and I shall, therefore, note to file this petition sufficiently early before that date.
