Many thanks for your above letter.


I am just begining to write the paper and hope to complete it within 10 days, when I will send you a draft for perusal. I hope it will not be too late for the publication.

I will concentrate upon Hyderabad city environs, as suggested by you, including some surrounding areas (within 100 kms. of the city), to give a comparative assessment and status of the birds seen by Dr. Salim Ali and those recorded by me and the BSAP. 
