I am compiling a Bibliographic Index to the ornithology of the Indian region (Part 1 of which is already published) and recently came across the following citation of a paper written by you.


**Uttangi, J C (1985): Bird fauna in the urban habitats of Hubli and Dharwad. MYFOREST.


Dear Dr. Uttangi,
