CCE-PROFICIENCE is established with the objective of providing with a sustained and rigorous continuing education program offering courses on subject of topical interest to scientists and engineers in and around Bangalore. This program offers semester long courses in the areas of topical interest. The courses are organized during evening hours during weekdays and mornings on Saturdays so that working professionals can participate without affecting their normal work. These courses are run on a semester basis, with two to three lecture hours scheduled per week. These courses are similar to those offered to the IISc students regularly.
