My dear Dr. Krishnan,

Some days ago I learned that it is possible you may take up the Directorship of the Council of Scientific & Industrial Research, and I desire to offer you my felicitations and best wishes for your success with it.

May I call to your attention the case of Dr. R. G. KHALSA, Senior Scientific Officer of the Council, who has been on deputation with the Indian Wheat Loan Educational Exchange Programme, of this Embassy, for the last several months as our Scientific Equipment Consultant. This deputation was arranged by agreement between the late Dr. S. S. Bhatnagar, FRS, and Dr. Clifford Manshardt of the Embassy.

Our Programme is to continue for at least several years longer, and it is our earnest desire to have Dr. Khalsa remain with us for perhaps two years if the Council is willing to spare him to us for that length of time. His services are valuable to us, and they contribute directly to the success of a Programme which will undoubtedly be of great benefit to Indian Universities and other high research institutions, including

several of those which are dependencies of the Council.

I have already written to Mr. D. Padmanabhan (Deputy Director, Technical, of the CSIR) requesting that Dr. Khalsa's deputation be extended without prejudice to his present position with the Council. I desire to bring this to your personal attention as well, and to bespeak your interest in it.
