My Dear Shri Mudaliar,

You may kindly recall my speaking and writing to you, some months ago, seeking your prior approval for my donating a sum of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand), out of my share of royalty for the baby food process, for the betterment of social amenities, medical care and such other benefits to the staff of Thiru Arooran Sugars. The proposal could not then be implemented because there was a Court case which was pending settlement.

Thanks to the interest of the various parties concerned, it has now been decided to reach a settlement and to report it to the Court on 12/7/74. The CSIR authorities are also interested in an early settlement and the disbursement of the amount which has accumulated with them. I am hoping therefore that the payment to Thiru Arooran Sugars could be made at least in the course of the next few months.

I do not yet know whether the payment will be made directly to the firm by the CSIR and whether it will be exempted from payment of tax as I have requested. If the CSIR authorities decide that the payment should be made through me, I will endeavour to pass on the amount - with or without tax - as soon as possible after I get it. At the same time, it may be necessary to consider in advance the steps to be taken to avoid the possibility of the payment being treated as an income to the company and being ~~suggax~~ subjected to further taxation. I would feel thankful for your kind advice in regard to the matter. It is intended as a donation for a cause and it will not represent an income to the company. If the payment is made through me, I will be glad to adopt any procedure which you may recommend. If a direct payment to Dr. Naidu, who is in charge of social welfare and health, is considered a workable solution, as I did on an earlier occasion, I will comply with it.
