The file was received in the library during the period when I was on leave on average pay for four months. After resuming my duty on 18th May 1950, I had no occasion to see the file. I had therefore no knowledge of the file and its contents at all. On

the 20th of this month I was on casual leave and the requisition for the file referred to me in my quarters. As I had no knowledge of it, I replied that the file was not received in the library. On the 21st, I was informed by Mr. Lal that the file was sent to the library on 11.4.50 according to an entry in the movement register maintained by him. This is the reason why it was not possible to trace it on the 20th Sept. 1950, the day on which I was on casual leave.
