HER EXCELLENCY THE CHANCELLOR:

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Chancellor of this University, I have great pleasure in admitting you, Dr. Krishnan, to the Degree of Doctor of Science Honoris Causa.

It is less than a month ago, Dr. Krishnan, that I gave you a very valuable piece of advice, which I hope you have taken to heart. You have had so much praise in your life that I think my piece of advice was very timely and very practical. Shall I tell them (the audience) what it was? You have done wonderful work for many years. You have laboured for Science with a disinterested love and with great ability, and your work has brought you great fame. I am too stupid to understand all the learned implications of your work. But I have seen with dismay as well as pride your one great fault, and that is, you are too modest and too unassuming; and in the cause of Science you must be arrogant! Do not believe that being assertive in Science is being conceited yourself. You have a gift to the world; give it with pride and give it with certainty. Your work will live I know. I am not so stupid as not to know that. And I wish you great success in the new work which you have undertaken and which I believe will bring great glory to India. But do not let me have to remind you a second time to hold up your chin and face the world, because you have brought a message for the world.

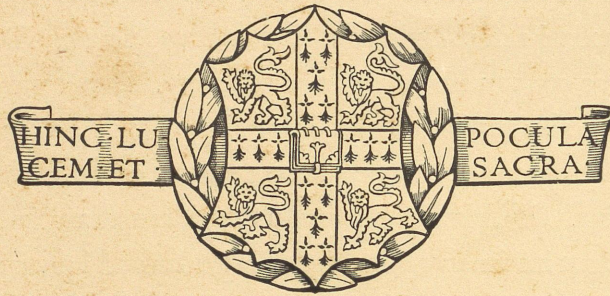
