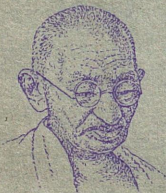

Please excuse me for the delay in writing to you. I have had a nice time after the madras trip. Parents are fine. As soon as I reached cochin, I have had a letter from Dr. Mungall with the good news that Dr. Samuel Beason of the Kleberg Wildlife Res. Institute of Texas A&I Univ. agreed to offer me a position in his project. She suggested me to apply and I did so. I am expecting the actual letter of offer from Dr. Beason. Another good news is, I need not take TOEFL! Instead of joining the Texas Univ. Dr. Beason, apparently suggested that I join his 18 month project first and then return to the

Univ. for the write up of results. If I feel like taking some course work in wildlife management, I can ~~also~~ ^{later} attend the course work. This is ~~the~~ the progress regarding the U.S. correspondence. I hope the things will come in my favour for the take off.

BNHS has accepted my paper for its Centenary Seminar in Dec. and my paper will be on 9/15. I have written to the ^{ZSI} Director requesting him for grant of funds. Although I am very skeptical about ^{his} accepting this visit, I still wanted to try. Due to non-release of funds by DoE, our project work has come to a stand-still. No more field visits till we receive the funds. Our Joint Director visited us on the 1st of Sept. and he felt very bad

at the things that are happening in this project. Of course, we have not left him. we strongly protested ~~at~~ the way we are getting the help from ZSI & DoE. If there are no funds, it's better to wind up the project. He agreed to do everything he could, to get the funds necessary. That's all. Till now no letter from him. I'm frustrated - frustrated and....

I am seriously looking for any job outside of U.S. trials come in favour it will be the greatest!
