Dear Mr. Bell,


I am writing at the instancce of Christopher Freeman at Sussex. I am looking for a suitable opening in Western Europe and Chris writes to say that opportunities might arise in the Division of Scientific Affairs of the OECD.

I am currently with the secretariat of the (Indian) National Committee on Science and Technology in the government of India. The NCST is the highest level advisory body to government on science and technology policy in India. This body is presently engaged in preparing a national science and technology plan. My work involves policy planning, research and analysis in the area of science and technology for the development of India. I drafted for the NCST a document entitled "An Approach to the Science and Technology Plan" which has now been published. I enclose two copies.

Although I have, nominally, a job that gives me much satisfaction, for some personal reasons I am seeking a position in Europe. I enclose my bio-data. As recorded there, I have a Ph.D. from the University of London and spent a year at the Science Policy Research Unit at Sussex. Apart from science and technology policy, my special interests include information management and systems analysis.


Dear Mr. Siddhartha,
