Dear Sir,

You are no doubt aware that under the auspices of the United Nations Organization an international conference on peaceful application of atomic energy will be held at Geneva from 8-21 Aug next. This is the first conference of its kind.

From 84 nations experts in the field of nuclear science and technology are invited to participate in order to get full information about their future intentions. We expect the conference will give a new impulse to scientific research in the nuclear field in a large number of countries.

An interesting feature of this conference will be an exhibition of nuclear equipment which will be held in the Palais de l'Exposition. As we expect some of your top scientists will take part in the conference, we extend them our invitation to the Philips corner where the following equipment are intended to be shown

- a 600 kV open cascade accelerator in compact execution
- some models of synchro cyclotrons
- a full range of radioactive radiation measuring equipment
- some isotope production control and supply apparatus

Our London friends M/s Philips Electrical Ltd are expected to participate in the section of British firms and they intend to display a linear accelerator model and some radiation measuring equipment.

For obtaining a more complete picture of the full range of the Philips nuclear equipment it may be worthwhile to visit the Philips Factory at Eindhoven after the Geneva conference. We shall be pleased to know the names of gentlemen who would be interested to visit Eindhoven so that the necessary arrangement can be made in advance.
