A Special General Meeting of the Royal Society will be held on Thursday 13 April 1961 at 4.30 p.m. to consider the following proposals by Council for alterations of Statutes 1, 3 and 17:

- (a) That the first twelve words of Statute 1 be altered to read as follows: 'Every candidate, who must be a British subject or Commonwealth citizen or citizen of the Irish Republic,...'.
- (b) That the first eight words of Statute 3 be deleted so that the Statute shall begin 'In December, a list...'.
- (c) That in Statute 17 the words 'who are not British subjects or Commonwealth citizens or citizens of the Irish Republic' be substituted for 'who are neither British subjects nor citizens of Eire'.
