Dear Shri Jetti:

The Mysore Lac & Paint Works Ltd., Mysore a "Govt. Company" in the Mysore State, sponsored by the Govt. of Mysore has taken over the Ink Development Project of the National Physical Laboratory as a going concern w.e.f. 1st June 1959. As the Ink Development Project, N.P.L. had a running contract with the Chief Controller of Printing and Stationery, Govt. of India, New Delhi for the supply of duplicating and other inks during the year 1959-60, The Mysore Lac & Paint Works Ltd. are working their pilot plant in New Delhi in our premises in order to ensure the continuity of supply to the States and the Stationery Depts. of the Govt. of India. They will be shifting the unit to Mysore about November 1959.

The Ink manufacturing unit requires about 60 h.p. of electric energy to work the plant. I shall be very happy if the necessary electric energy required by the company to work the plant is kindly sanctioned to the firm.

Duplicating and news print inks were being imported into the country. The manufacture of these inks have been taken up in our country only very recently, which has resulted in a saving of valuable foreign exchange. This industry has a bright future.
