Ref :- O.S.74 of 1969 now before the Mysore Civil Court

Sub :- Distribution of royalty in respect of the Baby
Food Process - Shri M.R. Chandrasekhara Vs CSIR
and others - Drafting of a compromise formula
acceptable to all the participants.

With reference to the above and the letter dt.28/3/74 as addressed by the Chief (Adm), CSIR to Shri Chandrasekhara on the above subject, I understand that the CSIR lawyer and also the lawyer engaged by Shri Chandrasekhara have already sent some draft proposals in respect of the 'form of consent' for your scrutiny.

As you may see from the papers in the related file, the proposal for a compromise was initiated by me some time during the latter half of 1973. Shri Chandrasekhara had agreed, in writing, to certain terms and I conveyed them to the DCSIR.

From what Shri Chandrasekhara has recently written to me, I have to infer that he has made some changes or interpreted the agreed terms in a different way. He got the concurrence of some of the people resident in and around Mysore and arranged with the lawyers to draft the proposals accordingly and then send them to you. It was only today that I heard about it.

I have no direct personal interest in the compromise formula as I have already offered to donate whatever amount I may get for certain causes. I will be glad to see an early conclusion of the litigation, so that all concerned may get the benefit of whatever may be due to them. At the same time, I am anxious that each of us should adhere to what we agree upon. I will have no objection if the terms drafted by the lawyers conform to what we had previously agreed upon. If there is a deviation. I would thank you to kindly draw the attention of the lawyers to it, so that they may make the appropriate revision. Alternately, you may kindly send a suitably worded draft for the consideration of the two lawyers in Mysore.
