Dear Sir,

I don't know whether you still remember me or not. I was one of your students at The Allahabad University in the post graduate class during the session 1945-46. (I am the nephew of late Dr. H. K. Ghosh of Indian Press Ltd, Allahabad).

After my M.Sc. I worked as a lecturer in Physics at various colleges under Patna University till 1951. When I came down to this Country for specialising in Radio Engineering. Here I first had undergone through a ten months' course at Marconi College, Chelmsford and subsequently joined the ~~firm~~ firm as a Research Engineer in their V. H. F. Receiver Section.

I hope, you know that our work is mostly connected with the development work rather than a fundamental research one. And we are at present busy in developing comm. sets under specific requirements laid down by the different departments of the Ministry of Supply (Between 200-800 mc/s). I am still very sure regarding my <sup>duration</sup> of stay in this Country, but I hope to stick to my present one for at least a couple of years more - ~~at least~~ to gain more experience.

However, ultimately I would like to return home and use my experience for the benefit of my Country. Had for this purpose I would like to join some research establishment or some Technical Institution where I shall be able to carry on my work besides any teaching duty.

As I have almost no knowledge and or information regarding this matter, I am writing this letter to you and I sincerely hope that you shall be kind enough to guide and advise me in this matter so that I may be able to use my knowledge and experience in the best possible manner.
