Subject:- Lists of words common to Hindi and other regional languages (Hindi Tamil) - Request for opinion.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the question of preparation of a dictionary of words common to Hindi and other regional languages had been under the consideration of the Government of India for some time past. In view of the great importance of such a comparative glossary not only for the terminological work, but also to give some idea of the rich stock of common vocabulary already existing in the country, it is the desire of the Government of India that the Glossary should be as comprehensive as possible. Keeping this in view it was decided to publish each glossary in the form of a separate provisional list. The list of words which are common to Hindi and Tamil has now been published.

I, therefore, forward herewith ^{a copy} ~~copies~~ of the list and request you to kindly forward your comments and suggestions on the words contained in this list as early as possible.

Any additional words you may kindly suggest for inclusion will be carefully examined in the Ministry.
