Letter No. 29489 dated 7th June 1939 from the Registrar, University of Mysore, recommending the grant to Dr.B.S.Madhava Rao,D.Sc., F.R.A.S., Professor of Mathematics, Central College, Bangalore, of an advance of four months' pay to enable him to purchase a motor car.

Order No.Fl.8048-50/G.F.353-38-2, dated 21st June 1939.

The grant of an advance of four months' pay, viz., Rupees one thousand and six hundred only (1,600/-) to Dr.B.S.Madhava Rao, Professor of Mathematics, Central College, Bangalore, is sanctioned, subject to the amount being drawn after 1st July 1939 and to strict compliance with the rules laid down in Article 162 of the Mysore Civil Account Code, Vol.I.

2. The advance will carry interest at 6% per annum.

3. The advance herein sanctioned should be regarded as the maximum that can be drawn from the Treasury and the Deputy Commissioner is requested to see that only so much as is required for the purchase of a motor car is claimed and that the necessary bond is executed before the advance is paid.

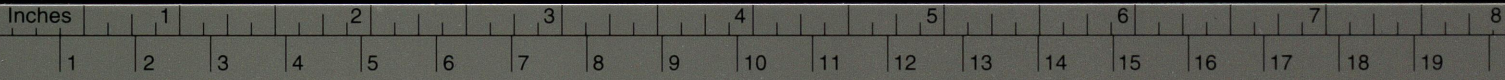
